1. Commissioners to meet, &c.—ex-

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota, That Sweet W. Case, A. L. Larpenteur and Dousin E. Moulton, are hereby appointed Commissioners to locate and mark out a Territorial Road, commencing at St. Paul in the County of Ramsey, and crossing the Mississippi river at or near the house of Stephen Desnoyer, and on or near the township line between Townships No. 28 and 29, and running from thence on the said Township line, to intersect the Territorial Road laid out from the Falls of St. Anthony to the line of Sibley County, and at or near Lake Calhoun.

Commissioners appointedto muke

Sec. 2. That the said Commissioners shall meet at St. Paul on the first Monday in May, 1851, or as soon as practicable thereafter. Provided, however, that in the absence of any one of said Commissioners appointed by this act, the others may have power to supply said vacancy by appointing another Commissioner, or may in case a majority of them meet, proceed in discharging their duties, and that it shall be left discretionary with a majority of said Commissioners, to adjourn from time to time as they deem proper, and the Commissioners, when assembled, shall proceed to mark and lay out said road, and the necessary expenses incurred in laying out said road shall be paid by the counties through which it may pass; each county tax for the same, to be set forth, upon the certificate of the said Commissioners, including the costs of survey, &c. Provided, the cost, and whole amount so paid, shall not exceed the sum of one hundred dollars.
