

CHAPTER 15.

Feb. 23, 1854.

An Act to provide for the laying out of a Territorial Road from St. Paul to Big Woods and Traverse des Sioux, on the East side of Minnesota River.

Commissioners
of road.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota, That Joseph Guion, N. Roberts, Louis Lacroix, and H. D. I, Koonce, be and the same are hereby appointed Commissioners, to locate and mark a Territorial Road from St. Paul, by way of Shakopee to the Big Woods to Traverse des Sioux, on the east side of Minnesota River.

May meet.

That the said Commissioners, or any three of them, shall meet at Shakopee in Scott County, on the first Monday of May next, or as soon thereafter as practicable, and proceed to lay out and mark said Road by the most direct and practicable route. The expense of laying out the same, to be paid by the Counties through which said road may pass. The above named Commissioners shall decide the proportion and amount of such expense, to be paid by each County through which the road may be located, and notify the Commissioners of each of said Counties of the same.
