An Act to provide or laying out a Territorial Road from Minneapolis to a point opposite the present village of Sauk Rapids.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota; That Washington Getchell, Anson Northrop, of Hennepin County, and David Gillman and Asa White, of Benton County, are hereby appointed commissioners to locate and mark a Territorial Road, commencing at the west end of the site selected for the Mississippi Bridge, or the west side of St. Anthony Falls, from thence on the most practicable route to a point opposite the centre of the present village of Sauk Rapids.

When to meetexpense.

Szc. 2. That the said Commissioners meet at the store of their Chambers in Minneapolis, on the first Monday in May next at ten o'clock A. m. or as soon as possible thereafter; Provided, however, that in the absence of any one of the Commissioners appointed by this act, the others may have power to supply said vacancy by appointing another Commissioner; or may in case a majority of them meet, proceed in discharging their duties, and that it shall be discretionary with a majority of said commissioners to adjourn from time time as they may deem proper, and the commissioners when assembled, shall proceed to lay out and mark said road, and the necessary expense incurred for laying out and establishing said road shall be paid by the county or counties through which said road may pass.
