CHAPTER XV.

An Act to provide that copies of Records in the offices of Registers of Deeds may be admissible in evidence.

SECTION 1. When deeds and copies of records may be received as evidence in courts of equity.

Be it enacted by the Legislative assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That copies of the records of all deeds, mortgages, town plats, or other investments of writing, relating to real estate within this Territory, when certified by the register of deeds of the county in which such investments are recorded to have been compared by him with the original records, and to be a correct transcript therefrom, may be read in evidence in like manner and with the same effect as the original records thereof.
