

CHAPTER XXXVI.

An Act to Locate the County-seat of Le Seuer County.

- SECTION 1. County seat of Le Seuer county located.
 2. Location of county buildings.
 3. When this act shall take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Minnesota Territory:

SECTION 1. That the county-seat of Le Seuer county be and the same is hereby located at Le Seuer City, any acts of the board of county commissioners of said county to the contrary notwithstanding. County-seat located.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That the county buildings of said county be and they are hereby located in block (49) forty-nine of said city. County buildings

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage. When act shall take effect.

CHAPTER XXXVII.

A Bill to Incorporate the Sisters Propagation of Faith Society of Saint Joseph, at Pembina.

- SECTION 1. "The Sisters Propagation of the Faith Society" made a body corporate.
 2. The persons named in section one to be managers of all donations to the institution.
 3. Of by-laws, rules and regulations.
 4. Capabilities and liabilities of the corporation.
 5. When this act shall take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

Made a body corporate.

SECTION 1. That Miss Isabella Gladen, Miss Sophia Lafevre and Miss Genevieve Grant, and their associates and successors in office, be and they are hereby made a body politic and corporate, to be known by the name and style of "The Sisters Propagation of the Faith Society," with the right as such, of suing and being sued, of contracting and being contracted with, and of making and using a common seal, and altering the same at pleasure.

Persons named in section one to be managers of all donations

SEC. 2. That the above named persons and their successors in office shall be managers of all sums of money, real estate or goods that could be donated or willed to this charitable institution.

By-laws, rules, and regulations.

SEC. 3. The said corporation shall have power to make by-laws, rules and regulations relative to the admission or addition of corporators and members, of their election, duties, time of service, appointment of suitable officers, excepting the president, who shall be always the catholic bishop of Pembina, or in his absence, the clergyman designated by him.

Capabilities, and liabilities of corporation.

SEC. 4. That said corporation shall be able and capable in law to purchase, improve and hold such real estate as may be necessary for the purpose of this incorporation, and to take, receive and hold all and all manner of lands, tenements, annuities, franchises, hereditaments, and any sums of money, and any manner and portion of goods, chattels, given or bequeathed to this corporation; and also to employ and dispose of, according to the object, provisions and conditions of this act, the articles and by laws of this corporation, and the will and intentions of the donor. *Provided*, The yearly income thereof shall not exceed ten thousand dollars.

Act take effect.

SEC. 5. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
