

## CHAPTER LX.

*An Act changing the name of Ann Elizabeth White to Ann Elizabeth Tinker.*

*Preamble*.—Petition for a change of the name of Ann Elizabeth White.

- SECTION 1. The name of Ann Elizabeth White changed to Ann Elizabeth Tinker.
2. Ann Elizabeth Tinker made the legal heir of William Tinker.
3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

*Whereas*, William H. Tinker of the county of Ramsey and Territory of Minnesota, has petitioned this Legislature to pass an act changing the name of Ann Elizabeth White, an infant of about five years of age, to that of Ann Elizabeth Tinker, and make her his legal heir, so as to enable the said Ann Elizabeth White to inherit the property of the said William H. Tinker, therefore,

*Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the lawful name of Ann Elizabeth White shall hereafter be Ann Elizabeth Tinker, by which name she shall be called and known to all legal intents and purposes.

SEC. 2. That the said Ann Elizabeth Tinker shall be fully capable in law to inherit from William H. Tinker any property which by law descends to his heirs at law, and shall have the same rights in relation to the property of the said William H. Tinker as if she were his child and heir.
