CHAPTER LXVIII.

An Act to authorize the construction of a Dam across the Crow River.

SECTION 1. E. H. Robinson and his associates authorized to construct dam.

2. The kind of dam to be constructed.

3. Powers reserved to the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Minnesota Territory:

Authorizing the construction of

SECTION 1. E. H. Robertson, his associates, successors, heirs and assigns, are hereby authorized to erect and maintain a dam across Crow River, at or near a point one third of a mile from the mouth of said river, and to make use of the water of said river for hydraulic purposes; Provided, that the construction of said dam shall not in any way infringe upon the rights of other persons not herein named.

Kind of dam.

SEC. 2. The said dam shall be so constructed as to admit of the passage of all rafts and water crafts and steamboats, and the said rafts or water crafts shall at any time be entitled to pass through the said dam free of all charges to the owners of said rafts or water crafts; *Provided*, that nothing in this bill shall be so construed as to conflict with the ordinance of '87, the Conststution of the United States or the organic act.

Powers reserved.

Sec. 3. The Legislature may at any time alter or amend this act when it shall be considered proper to provide for the improvement of the said Crow River.
