# CHAPTER CII.

#### An Act to locate a Territorial Road from the Old Sioux Crossing, opposite Traverse des Sioux, by the Doys' Lodge and Vermilion Prairie. to the Mendota and Big Sioux Road, at some point near Mendota.

Names of Commissioners. SECTION 1. 2. Commissioners employ surveyor.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. Henry Belan, Jack Fraver, and John Donnelly, be, and Names of Commission ers are hereby commissioned to lay out and locate a Territorial road, from the old Sioux crossing, opposite the town of Traverse des Sioux, by way of the Dog's Lodge and Vermilion Prairie, to the Mendota and Big Sioux road at some point near Mendota.

SEC. 2. The said commissioners are hereby authorized to employ a Employ surveyor competent surveyor, to survey and make a map of said road, and whenever the map so made and an accompanying report from said commissioners be deposited with the Secretary of the Territory, the said road shall be considered permanently located. Provided, that the different counties through which the road may pass shall defray the expenses of locating the same.

## CHAPTER CIII.

An Act to provide for laying out a Territorial Road from the Forks of Crow River, opposite Greenwood, via the head of Buffalo Lake, to intersect the Territorial Road running from Minneapolis to St. Cloud.

SECTION 1. Names of Commissioners.

Time and place of meeting. 2.

3. File copy of map.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That George A. J. Overton, Amasa Ackley, Lewis B. Names of com-Collver, John M. Keeler and Samuel Chamblin, be, and are hereby missioners appointed Commissioners to locate and mark out a Territorial Road from the forks of Crow River at a point opposite Greenwood, by the way of the head of Buffalo Lake, to intersect the Territorial Road running from Minneapolis to St. Cloud, at such point as the commissioners appointed to locate said road, shall appear most fit and proper.

Place of meeting

And be it further enacted, That said Commissioners, or any SEC. 2. three of them, shall meet at the house of Geo. A. J. Overton, at Buffalo Lake, in Wright county, on the first day of March, eighteen hundred and fifty-six, or as soon thereafter as practicable, and proceed to lay out and mark said road by the most direct and feasible route, the expenses of the same to be paid by the counties through which the above described road may pass. The above named Commissioners shall decide the proportion and amount of said expenses to be paid by each county through which the road may be located, and notify the Commissioners of each of said counties of the same.

Deposit copy of map

SEC. 3. Said Commissioners shall file in each of the organized counties, through which said road shall pass, a map of said road and the field notes of said survey, and when said map and notes shall be filed as aforesaid, the said road shall become a legal highway.

# CHAPTER CIV.

An Act to Provide for the laying out of a Territorial Road from Winone to Owatonia.

SECTION 1. Names of Commissioners. Time and place of meeting. 2.

### Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That Peter Mantor, A. B. Waterman and George O. Way, are hereby appointed Commissioners to locate and mark a Territcrial road, commencing at Winona, and from thence on the most practicable route By Rochester, Mantorville to Owatonia.

SEC. 2. That the said Commissioners meet at the house of Peter Mantor in Mantorville, on the first Monday of April next, at 10 o'clock, P. M., or as soon as possible thereafter. Provided, however, that in the absence of any of the Commissioners appointed by this act, the others may have power to supply said vacancy by appointing another Commissioner, or may in case a majority of them meet, proceed to discharge the duties, and it may be discretionary with a majority of said Commissioners to adjourn from time to time as they may deem proper, and said Commissioners when as-
