

CHAPTER LXI.

An Act to attach a certain portion of Sibley County to LeSueur County.

- SECTION 1. County of LeSueur.
 2. Inconsistent acts repealed.
 3. When to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That all that part of sections number twenty-five, south half of section twenty-six and section thirty-five, of township number one hundred and twelve, Range twenty-six west, lying on the west side of the Minnesota River, be and is hereby attached to the county of LeSueur.

Act Repealed. SEC. 2. All acts heretofore passed, inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

To be in force. SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXII.

An Act to organize the County of Brown.

- SECTION 1. County of Brown declared to be organized.
 2. County Seat.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

Brown county. SECTION 1. That the county of Brown is hereby declared to be an organized county, and entitled to all privileges and immunities, and subject to all liabilities of other organized counties of this Territory.

County Seat. SEC. 2. That the County Seat of Brown county shall be at the town of New Ulm, on the Minnesota River, and that the Governor of this Territory is hereby invested with full power to appoint all county officers for said county, who shall hold their offices from the time of their appointment until the next general election. There shall be at least one term of

the District Court held in the county of Brown in each year, at such time as the Judge of the District in which said county shall be, shall appoint.

CHAPTER LXIII.

An Act to locate the County Seat of Wabashaw County.

- SECTION 1. Locating the County Seat.
2. When to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the County Seat of Wabashaw county be and the same is hereby located on Block thirty-one (31), in the town of Wabashaw, County Seat. as surveyed in July, A.D., 1854, by S. A. Hart, and recorded in the Book of Town Plats of Wabashaw county.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
