> Change of Name. SECTION 1. 2. To be in force.

Name changed.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota: That the name of the minor orphan child heretofore known SECTION I. as Serena M. Huntly, is hereby changed to Serena Marie Ames; and at the request of the parties, she is declared to be legally the adopted daughter of Charles G, and Sarah Jane Ames, being subject to all such obligations and duties, and entitled to all such privileges, advantages and inheritances as would accrue to the said Screna were she the natural daughter of the said Charles G. and Sarah Jane Ames.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXX.

A Bill to Authorize the County Commissioners of Hennepin County to Borrow money on the County Bonds for the purpose of erecting County Buildings.

Section 1. Commissioners authorized to borrow money.

Property to be taxed to pay principal and interest.

3. When to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

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Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners of the county of Hennepin in the Territory of Minnesota are hereby authorized to borrow on the credit of said county, a sum of money not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of twenty thousand dollars, at a rate of interest not exceeding twelve per cent per annum, and in such amounts and on such terms as to the said Board shall seem proper, for the purpose of erecting a Court House, Jail and Office for the Register of Deeds of said county, and for that purpose the said Board of County Commissioners may issue the bonds of said county of Hennepin, signed by the said Commissioners and attested by the Clerk of said Board, and under the seal of said county, which bonds so issued shall be and continue a lien upon the property in said county until the same are fully paid and satisfied.

Bonds.

SEC. 2. For the purpose of paying the principal and interest to become due upon said bonds as the same may become due, the said Board of County Commissioners are hereby authorized and required to raise by tax upon the taxable property in said county, in the usual manner of assessing and collecting taxes for county purposes, a sufficient sum of money and in such amounts and at such times as may be necessary to meet the sum of money to become due on said bonds as fast as the same may become due, and as soon as said bonds shall be paid, the same shall be cancelled by the said Board.

Payment of Interest.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

Village lots nine and ten in block seventy-two in the town of Minneapolis, in Hennepin county, as the same are known and designated in the survey and plat of said town, recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds for said county, and such other lots adjoining thereto, as may be conveyed to said county for that purpose as hereinafter prescribed, are here—site for buildings by designated as the site whereon to erect the county buildings in and for said county of Hennepin.
