## CHAPTER LXXIV.

An Act to anend an act entitled an act providing for the survey of Cogs
and Lumber in Minnucsota Territory, approved MIarch 1st, 1854.
Sectiox 1. What shall constitute the everal districts.
2. When to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Leyislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:
Section 1. That section two of said act be and the same is hereby amegled so as to read as follows :

Seg. 2. The St.Croix River and its tributaries shall constitute the first St. Croix river and Elk river (excepting the St. Croix) shall constitate the second District. The Mississippi river and its tributaries below the mouth of the St. Croix river shall constitate the third District. The Mississippi river and its tributaries above the mouth of Elt river shall constitate the fourth District.

The Survegor General of the fourth District shall keep his office at Little Falls.

To take effoct.
Bcc. 8. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
