## CHAPTER LXXXVI.

An Act for a Territorial Road from Minneapolis to Glencoe.

Section 1. Winona to Wabashaw.

2. Winona to Iowa Line.

3. Time and place of meeting.

4. Commissioners deposite copy of maps.

Power to appoint substitute.

3. Expenses, how paid.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

Names of Commissioners

SECTION 1. That Thomas W. Pierce, Edwin Hedderl, and John H. Stevens, be and are hereby appointed Commissioners to locate and mark out a Territorial Road from Minneapolis to Glencoe, via. Lake Calhoun near Bass Lake, (so called,) to John P. Miller's, and thence by the way of Excelsior to Glencoe.

Place of meeting

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted that the said Commissioners shall meet at the office of John H. Stevens, in Minneapolis, Hennepin county, on or before the first Monday of May, 1856, or as soon thereafter as practicable, and proceed to lay out and mark said road, by the most direct and feasible route, the expenses of the same to be paid by the counties through which said road shall pass. The above Commissioners shall decide the proportion and amount of expenses to be paid by each county through which the road shall be located, and notify the Commissioners of each county of the same.

Appoint aubstitutes SEC. 3. The above named Commissioners shall have power to appoint substitutes.

Deposit copy of map

SEC. 4. Said Commissioners shall deposit a copy of the survey and location of said road with the several clerks of the Board of County Commissioners in the counties through which the road may pass.

To be in force.

Sec. 5. This act to be in force from and after its passage.
