

CHAPTER LXXXVII.

An Act Providing for the laying out and establishing a Territorial road from Winona to Austin.

- SECTION 1: Names of Commissioners.
 2. Time and place of meeting.
 3. Expenses, how paid.
 4. Power to appoint substitute.
 5. When to take effect.
 6. Deposit copy of map.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That Isaac Arnold and R. S. Nichols, of Chatfield, and Gideon Sherman of Mower county, be and the same are hereby appointed Commissioners to locate and mark a Territorial Road from the town of Winona, in Winona county, by the way of Chatfield in Fillmore county, and south half of section thirteen, township 103 north, Range 14 west, to the town of Austin, in Mower county. Commissioners

SEC. 2. That the said Commissioners shall meet at Chatfield on the first Monday of April next, or as soon thereafter as practicable, and proceed to lay out and mark said road by the most direct and feasible route. Meeting

SEC. 3. The expense of locating the said road shall be paid by the several counties through which said road may be located. The Commissioners shall decide the proportion and amount of said expense to be paid by each county through which said road may be located. Expenses paid

SEC. 4. In case of the inability of either of the above named Commissioners to perform the duties assigned him in this act, he shall have the power to appoint a substitute. Substitutes

SEC. 5. This act to take effect from and after its passage. Take effect

SEC. 6. The above named Commissioners shall cause to be deposited in the office of the Register of Deeds in each of the organized counties through which said road may pass, a copy of the maps of the survey of said road. Deposit map
