

CHAPTER LXXXIX.

A Bill to provide for the laying out of a Territorial Road from Manhattan via the head of Buffalo Lake and Red Cedar Island Lake to Traverse des Sioux.

- SECTION 1. Names of Commissioners.
 2. Time and place of meeting.
 3. Deposit copy of map.
 4. When to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota.

SECTION 1. That Lewis B. Collver, George A. J. Overton, Christopher Davis, Amasa Ackley, Samuel Chamblin and John M. Keeler, be, and are hereby appointed Commissioners to locate and mark out a Territorial Road from Manhattan, on the Mississippi, by the way of the head of Buffalo Lake and Red Cedar Island Lake, to Traverse des Sioux on the Minnesota river.

Commissioners

Meeting

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That said Commissioners, or any three of them, shall meet at the house of Lewis B. Collver, at Lake Pulaske, in Wright county, on the first day of March, eighteen hundred and fifty-six, or as soon thereafter as practicable, and proceed to lay out and mark said road by the most direct and feasible route, the expenses of the same to be paid by the counties through which the above described road may pass. The above named Commissioners shall decide the proportion and amount of said expenses to be paid by each county through which the road may be located, and notify the Commissioners of each of said counties of the same.

Deposit map

SEC. 3. The said Commissioners shall cause to be deposited in the offices of the Registers of Deeds of the boundaries through which said road may pass, a copy of the map of the survey of said road, which shall be legal evidence that said road has been surveyed and marked out, in accordance with the provisions of this act.

Take effect

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force immediately after its passage.
