[CHAPTER XCVIII.

An Act Providing for the laying out and establishing a Territorial Road from Henderson to Fort Ridgely.

SECTION 1. Names of Commissioners.

Time and place of meeting. 2.

Time and place of maximum.
Deposit copy of map.
Power to appoint Substitute.

5. Take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That Joseph R. Brown, John Fadden, and F. Wigand be, Names of Com and the same are hereby appointed Commissioners to locate and mark a missioners Territorial Road from the town of Henderson, in Sibley County, to Fort Ridgely, and said road, when laid out as herein provided shall in connection with the road already laid out from Minneapolis to Henderson, constitute the Territorial Road from Minneapolis to Fort Ridgely.

That the said Commissioners shall meet at Henderson on the SEC. 2. first Monday of March next, or as soon thereafter as practicable, and proceed to lay out and mark said road by the most direct and feasible route.

SEC. 3. The Commissioners shull cause to be deposited in the office of Deposit map Register of Deeds of the counties through which said road may pass, a copy of the maps of the survey of said road.

SEC. 4. In case of the inability of either of the above named Com- Substitutes missioners to perform the duties assigned him in this act, he shall have the power to appoint a substitute.

SEC. 5. The several counties through which this road may pass shall Expenses paid pay for the survey and location thereof.

SEC. 6. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its pas- Take effect sage.
