

CHAPTER XCIX.

A Bill to provide for laying out certain Territorial roads.

- SECTION 1. Minneapolis to Shakopee.
 2. Hennepin county to Forest City.
 3. Minneapolis to Glencoe.
 4. Time and place of meeting.
 5. Power to appoint substitute.
 6. Expenses, by whom paid.
 7. Take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:

Minneapolis to Shakopee SECTION 1. That Oliver Keep, Hugh Dorsey, Joseph Harrison, and Jas. Mountain, are hereby appointed Commissioners to lay out and establish a Territorial Road on the most feasible route from Minneapolis in Hennepin county, by way of Murphy's Ferry, to Shakopee, in Scott county.

Hennepin county to Forest city SEC. 2. John Huey, Thomas Skinner, George Fletcher, and Thomas Hanson are hereby appointed commissioners to lay out and establish a Territorial Road on the most feasible route from Hennepin county, by way of Greenwood, on Crow river, to Forest city in Wright County.

Minneapolis to Hutchinson SEC. 3. John H. Stevens, Herrington and Henry Chambers, are hereby appointed Commissioners to lay out and establish a Territorial Road from Minneapolis by way of the north side of Lake Minnetonka to Glencoe, with a branch to Hutchinson.

Meeting SEC. 4. The commissioners for the location of either of the above named roads, or a majority of them, may meet at such place as may be deemed most convenient on any day subsequent to the passage of this act, and may proceed to lay out the respective roads at such time within six months from the passage hereof, as may best suit the convenience of the several Boards of Commissioners.

Substitutes SEC. 5. If any of the Commissioners named in this act shall refuse or neglect to act, after being notified of the time appointed for the commencement of the location of a road, then his associate Commissioners may select and appoint some other person to act on said Board, and the person so elected and appointed shall perform the duties with all the power he would have possessed if named in this act.

Expenses paid SEC. 6. The expense of locating the several roads shall be paid out of any money in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated, on the presentation of the proper warrants of the Territorial Auditor.

Take effect. SEC. 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
