A Memorial to Congress for an Appropriation of \$10,000 for the construction of Bridges and Culverts on a Territorial Road from the Iowa State Line, via Richland, Preston and Chatfield, to Rochester, in Minnesota Territory.

To the Honorable the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States in Congress Assembled: The Memorial of the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota respectfully represents to your Honorable Body: *For an appropriation for the construction of Culverts and Bridges*

That the sum of ten thousand dollars will be necessary to construct Bridges and Culverts on the Territorial Road from the Iowa State line via Richland, Preston and Chatfield, to Rochester, in Minnesota Territory. That said Territorial road connects with the Iowa State road extending from Dubuque to the north line of the State, and is a continuation of said State road. That the interests and prosperity of the inhabitants of that portion of the Territory would be greatly promoted, and the large number of emigrants coming into our Territory through the State of Iowa, would be particularly benefitted by having Bridges constructed across the streams on said road. Your Memorialists therefore ask your Honorable Body to make an appropriation of \$10,000 for the construction of Bridges and Culverts on said road, for which your Memorialists are in duty bound and will ever pray.
