## NUMBER VI.

A Joint Resolution of the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota, for the relief of the Clerks of the Council and House of Representatives.

Appropriations

Resolved, (the House of Representatives concurring,) that there shall be allowed to the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives, for extra services and for writing up the Journal of the House of Representatives, &c., the sum of two hundred dollars. That there shall be allowed to the Second Clerk of the House of Representatives, for extra services, the sum of one hundred dollars. That there be allowed to the Enrolling Clerk of the House of Representatives, for extra services, and as compensation for services of extra Clerks, the sum of one hundred and seventy-five dollars.

Resolved, That there shall be allowed to the Sccretary of the Council, for extra services, and for preparing an index to the Journal of the Council for the present session, the sum of two hundred dollars; to the Assistant Secretary for extra services, the sum of one hundred dollars, and to the Enrolling Clerk of the Council for extra services, and as compensation for services of extra Clerks, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars.

Resolved, That if the Secretary of the Territory shall refuse to pay said sum, or there be no monies in said Secretary's possession, to defray such expense, then the said Secretary shall attach his certificate to the order of the said Clerks certifying to the same, and when said order is presented to the Territorial Auditor of this Territory, said Auditor shall draw his warrant upon the Territorial Treasurer of this Territory, who shall, upon the presentation of said Warrant, pay the said amount out of any monies belonging to the Territory, which may be in his possession.
