

SEC. 2. If any person shall, within this State, shoot, trap or kill in any manner, any grouse, prairie-chicken, partridge or quail between the fifteenth day of February and the fifteenth day of July following, he shall for every such offense, forfeit and pay the sum of five dollars, to be collected in the same manner and paid over to the same use as is provided in the preceding section.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER XX.

### *An Act to provide for the Qualification of Clerks of the District Court.*

SECTION 1. Clerks of Court to take oath of office—form of oath.

2. Duties and powers, same as prescribed in Revised Statutes of the Territory of Minnesota.

3. Act takes effect on passage.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That any person who has been or who shall hereafter be elected to the office of Clerk of the District Court in this State, shall, before entering upon the discharge of the duties of his office, take and subscribe to an oath or affirmation of office before a Justice of the Peace, or some other person authorized by law to administer oaths, which oath or affirmation shall be in the following form, to-wit: I ———, do solemnly swear (or affirm, as the case may be,) to support the Constitution of the United States, and of the State of Minnesota, and faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of the office of Clerk of the District Court for the

County of— to the best of my knowledge and ability, during my continuance therein, so help me God, (or under the pains and penalties of perjury,) which oath or affirmation shall be endorsed upon the certificate of his election and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of his proper county.

Sec. 2. The duties, powers and compensation of the several Clerks of the District Court, shall be the same as now prescribed by the Revised Statutes of the Territory of Minnesota, for such officers, until otherwise provided by law.

Sec. 3. This Act shall take effect from and after its passage.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That so much of section sixteen, in township
