## OHAPTER LXIII.

An Act to require Clerks of District Courts, Judges of District Courts and District Attorneys to file copies of their official bonds and oaths in the office of the Clerk of the Supreme Court.

SECTION. 1. Oathu and Bonds of Judges and Clerks of District Court to be filed with Clerk of Supreme Court.

- 2. Duties of Clerk of Supreme Court, with reference thereto.
- 3. Certificate of Clerk of Supreme Court prima facie evidence of their official
- character. 4. Act takes effect on passage.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION I. The several Judges of the District Courts, Oath of office and Clerks of the District Courts and District Attorneys, are here-boards of judges by required to file or cause to be filed in the office of the rict courts folled Clerk of the Supreme Court, certified copies of their official with clerk of raoaths or bonds, or both, as the case may be.

SEC. 2. It is hereby made the duty of the Clerk of the Supreme Court to file the said oaths and bonds in his said office, free of all charges whatsoever, and it is further made Duty of moreme the duty of the Clerk of the Supreme Court, in case of the failure of any of the officers herein enumerated so to do, to notify said officers of this requirement, and request compliance with the same.

SEC. 3. The certificate of the Clerk of the Supreme Court to the official acts of any of the said officers shall be taken as *prima facic* evidence of their official character, in any of the Courts of this State.

SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
