CHAPTER CXXIV.

An Act to Establish the County of Monongalia.

SECTION 1. Boundaries of the county. 2. Appointment of county Commissioners.

- Meuting of Commissioners. 3.
- Included in the Fourth Judicial Di trict.
- Subject to the approval of the voters interested.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

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SECTION 1. That so much of the Territory as is embraced

within the following limits be and the same is hereby established as the County of Monongalia, viz: Commencing on the county the line between Meeker and Renville Counties, at the South-see chap 57 east corner of Township 118, north of Range 83, west of fifth principal meridian; thence west to the south-west corner of Township 118, north of Range 35 west, thence due north thirty miles to the north-west corner of Township 122. Range 35; thence east to the north-cast corner of Township 122. north of Range 33 west; thence south to the place of beginning.

SEC. 2. That George C. Wilson, Newton Pierpoint, and Daties of the William Wheeler, shall constitute a Board of County Com-county commissioners for said County, with full power and authority to missioners perform all the duties usually devolving upon such officers.

SEC. 3. The said Commissioners shall, upon the second Monday after this Act goes into effect, meet at the town of Irving, which is hereby made the county seat of said Monongalia County, and shall appoint a Register of Deeds and a Sheriff, who shall perform the duties usually allotted to such office, and continue in office until their successors shall have been elected at the next general election, and sworn in ; and said Sheriff shall qualify and give bonds according to the requirements of law.

Sec. 4. The said county shall be included in the Fourth in 4th judicial district Judicial District.

SEC. 5. At the next general election, the electors of the several counties affected by the change shall vote for or voters of adagainst the organization of said County; and this Act shall joining coun-take effect from the time that such organization is assented the ameted by to by a majority of the said electors.
