

CHAPTER XIV.

An Act to locate a State road from the west end of the Saint Anthony and North Minneapolis bridge to the western boundary of the State.

- SECTION 1. Board of Commissioners.
 2. Meeting of Board.
 3. Right to appoint substitute.
 4. Expenses to be paid by the several counties.
 5. Filing of plat or map.
 6. Take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Commissioners SEC. 1. That Isaac I. Lewis, of Hennepin county, Dr. J. V. Kennedy, of McLeod county, and Eli F. Lewis, of Carver county, be, and are hereby appointed commissioners to locate mark, survey and establish a State road from the west end of the Saint Anthony and North Minneapolis bridge, by the way of Watertown, Winstead, Byron, Cedar City, Kandiyohi and Whitefield to the Western boundary of the State of Minnesota.

Meeting

SEC. 2. The said commissioners, or a majority of them, shall meet at the office of Isaac I. Lewis, in Minneapolis, on the third Monday in February, A. D. 1858, and then proceed to locate and survey said road.

Appoint substitute

SEC. 3. In case the majority of the above named commissioners should fail to convene on the day, as provided in section two, it shall be the duty of the commissioner that may be in attendance on the day so specified, to appoint substitute.

Expenses—how paid

SEC. 4. The expenses incurred in the establishing and surveying of said road, shall be paid by the several counties through which the road may pass.

Filing maps &c

SEC. 5. The map, or plat, or survey of said road, shall be filed by the commissioners in the office of the Secretary of the State of Minnesota, and with the several Registers of Deeds of the counties through which the road may pass, on or before the first Monday of November, A. D. 1858.

Take effect

SEC. 6. That this act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XV.

An Act to provide for the laying out of certain State Roads in the State of Minnesota.

SECTION 1 to 91. Commissioners appointed to locate State Roads.

92. Meeting of Commissioners.

93. Expenses to be paid by the several counties.

94. Deposit copy of plat.

95. Deposit correct account of expense incurred.

96. Take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That John Fadden, Francis Baasen, and J. B. Calkins, are hereby appointed Commissioners to locate, survey and establish a State Road from Henderson, in Sibley County, via Redstone, New Ulm, to intersect the Nobles Wagon Road to the Pacific, near the crossing of the Big Cottonwood. Commissioners appointed to locate state road from Henderson to Big Cottonwood

SEC. 2. That L. H. Obert, Dr. Nathan Stanton, and Caleb Dorr, are hereby appointed Commissioners to locate, survey and establish a State Road from Winnebago, in Stearns County, via Granite City, in Morrison County, Saganaw, Mille Lac Lake, Portage City, near Sandy Lake, to Fon du Lac on Fon du Lac Bay. Winnebago to Fon du Lac

SEC. 3. That ——— Johnson, L. H. Obert and James Whitehead, are hereby appointed Commissioners to locate, survey and establish a State Road from Little Falls, in Morrison County, via Granite City, Hanover, on Rum River, Sterling, on Mille Lac Lake, thence to intersect the Government Road from St. Paul to Superior. Little Falls to Sterling

SEC. 4. That Jas. L. Curtis, Thomas Cathcart and George Jones, are hereby appointed Commissioners to locate, survey and establish a State Road from Princeton, in Benton County, via Granite City, to Crow Wing. Princeton to Crow Wing

SEC. 5. That John Fortune, Lars Larson and Elias Lint,
