CHAPTER CXLII.

An Act to authorize the Register of Deeds of Blue Earth County to copy from the Records of Ramsey County.

SECTION I. Authority to Register of Blue Earth County to copy records from Ramsey County.

2. Fees of Register of Deeds.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That it shall be lawful for the Register of Deeds of the county of Blue Earth, to copy from the records of

Ramsey county, all deeds, mortgages, and other evidences of Register of titles now remaining of record in the county of Ramsey, in Deeds of Blue all cases where the lands are situated in the county of Blue Earth county to copyrecords
Earth.

SEC. 2. That the aforesaid Register of Deeds, shall be en-county titled to the same fees for said services, as he is entitled to Fees of Regisby law for making original records, to be paid out of the ter of Deeds county treasury of Blue Earth county.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect and be in force from
