The expenses of location, survey and establishment of said roads shall be paid by the counties through which said roads may pass, in proportion to the distance said roads may be located in such counties, except such road or roads as are otherwise provided for in this act: Provided, That no expense shall be allowed on any portion of the aforesaid roads which had been previously located.

SEC. 94. The said commissioners shall cause to be deposited in the offices of the Register of Deeds of the organized counties through which said roads may pass a copy of the plat of said roads, exemplification of which shall be legal evidence of the opening and existence of said roads.

Szc. 95. Each board of commissioners appointed by this act, or their substitute, shall make out and deposit or cause to be deposited with the clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of the several counties through which said road may pass a true and correct account of the expense incurred in the location, survey and establishment of said road through their respective counties; and all bills or accounts so presented or deposited shall be, and such County Commissioners shall audit such bills and accounts and allow all fair and proper charges and expenses for laying out such roads.

Take effect

This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
