CHAPTER XV.

An Act to provide for the laying out of certain State Roads in the State of Minnesota.

- SECTION 1 to 91. Commissioners appointed to locate State Roads.
 92. Meeting of Commissioners.
 93. Expenses to be paid by the several counties.
 94. Deposit copy of plat.
 95. Deposit correct account of expense incurred.
 96. Take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That John Fadden, Francis Baasen, and J. B. Calkins, are hereby appointed Commissioners to locate, survey and establish a State Road from Henderson, in Sibley County, via Redstone, New Ulm, to intersect the Nobles Wagon Road to the Pacific, near the crossing of the Big Cottonwood. Commissioners appointed to locate state road from Henderson to Big Cottonwood

SEC. 2. That L. H. Obert, Dr. Nathan Stanton, and Caleb Dorr, are hereby appointed Commissioners to locate, survey and establish a State Road from Winnebago, in Stearns County, via Granite City, in Morrison County, Saganaw, Mille Lac Lake, Portage City, near Sandy Lake, to Fon du Lac on Fon du Lac Bay. Winnebago to Fon du Lac

SEC. 3. That ——— Johnson, L. H. The commissioners for the location and establishment of either of the above-mentioned roads may meet at such place as may be deemed most convenient, on any day subsequent to the passage of this act, and may proceed to lay out the respective roads at such time within twelve months from the passage hereof as may best suit the conveniences of the several boards of commissioners.

Meeting

SEC. 92. If any of the commissioners named in this act shall refuse or neglect to act, after being notified of the time appointed for the commencement of the location of the road, then his associate commissioners may select and appoint some other person to act on said board, and the person or persons so elected or appointed shall perform the duties and be possessed of all the powers that he or they would have been possessed of were they particularly mentioned in this act.

Appoint substitute

SEC. 93. The expenses of location, survey and establishment of said roads shall be paid by the counties through which said roads may pass, in proportion to the distance said roads may be located in such counties, except such road or roads as are otherwise provided for in this act: *Provided*, That no expense shall be allowed on any portion of the aforesaid roads which had been previously located.

Expenses

SEC. 94. The said commissioners shall cause to be deposited in the offices of the Register of Deeds of the organized counties through which said roads may pass a copy of the plat of said roads, exemplification of which shall be legal evidence of the opening and existence of said roads.

Deposit plat

Commissioners
to audit bills

SEC. 95. Each board of commissioners appointed by this act, or their substitute, shall make out and deposit or cause to be deposited with the clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of the several counties through which said road may pass a true and correct account of the expense incurred in the location, survey and establishment of said road through their respective counties; and all bills or accounts so presented or deposited shall be, and such County Commissioners shall audit such bills and accounts and allow all fair and proper charges and expenses for laying out such roads.

Take effect

SEC. 96. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
