SECTION 1. That N. Reddmon, George Babcock, and Elias

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Lint, are hereby appointed Commissioners to mark out and Appointment locate a State Road, commencing at the town of Rushford in of commissionthe county of Fillmore, and to extend to the town of Forrest-ens ville, in same county; the road to be located in the valley of the south fork of Root River.

SEC. 2. The said Commissioners shall meet at Rushford, Meeting of the on the first Monday in October, A. D, 1858, or as soon there-commissioners after as practicable, and proceed to discharge the duties imposed on them by the provisions of this Act : *Provided*, however, That in the absence of any one of said Commissioners appointed by this Act, the others may have power to supply said vacancy by appointing another Commissioner, or may in case a majority of them meet, proceed to discharge their duties.

SEC. 3. The said Commissioners shall make out a fair and accurate draft of the location of said road, one copy whereof Draft of road shall be deposited in the office of the Clerk of the Board of to be deposited County Supervisors of the county of Fillmore.
