

## CHAPTER CLXXI.

*An Act to extend the time for the Collection of Taxes in the counties of Wright, Benton, Stearns, Sherburne and Morrison.*

1. Time of collection of Taxes extended to November, 1858.
2. When returns of taxes shall be made.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That the time for the collection of taxes in the counties of Wright, Stearns, Benton, Sherburne and Morrison, for the year 1857, be and the same is hereby extended to the third Monday in November, 1858. *Time extended* *Provided,* That if any person against whom any tax for either of said counties remains unpaid, shall be about to change his residence from either of said counties, then the Collector of the county from which such person is about to move shall proceed to collect the tax standing against such person, according to the laws in force previous to the passage of this Act.

SEC. 2. The Collector of Taxes for said counties of Wright, Benton, Stearns, Sherburne and Morrison, shall make his returns to the proper authorities, on the third Monday of December, 1858. And said collector shall immediately pay over to the proper authorities all the taxes collected by him previous to the passage of this Act. *Returns when made*

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect from and after its passage.
