SEC. 4. In the event either of said Commissioners shall be unable to perform the duties assigned him in this Act, he shall have power to appoint a substitute, and it shall be his duty to notify the other Commissioners of such substitution: Provided, That if at the first meeting mentioned in the Second Section of this bill, either of said Commissioners shall fail to appear in person or by duly authorized substitute, the said appointment shall be declared cancelled, and the Commissioner or Commissioners, or their duly authorized substitute or substitutes there present, shall have the power to select suitable persons to fill such vacancy or vacancies.

Per diem

SEC. 5. That said Commissioners shall be allowed the sum of two dollars per day, for the time necessarily occupied in the location of said road, and they are empowered to employ one surveyor, at two dollars per day, two chain-men and one axe-man at a sum not exceeding one dollar and fifty cents per day.

SEC. 6. This Act shall take effect on and after its pas-

CHAPTER CLXXIV.

An Act to legalize certain acts of the Town Council of La Crescent, in the County of Houston.

SECTION 1. Certain contracts of Town Council legalized.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the acts of the Town Council of the town

of La Crescent, so far as relates to any contract or agreement made by the said town with Thomas McRoberts, or any other member of the La Crescent Gravel and Plank Road Com-Certain es pany, for the completion of a gravel and plank road from a tractal spanned point within a hundred feet of the bank of the Mississippi River, to a point in the town of La Crescent designated in Section (2) of an Act entitled An Act to incorporate the La Crescent Gravel and Plank Road Company, approved March 7th 1857, and the execution of bonds or notes by said Council, or its President, for borrowed money to finish said road in accordance with the vote of said town, to authorize said Council to borrow or hire money for that purpose, and also, the appointment of the Collector of tax for said town, are hereby legalized and confirmed.

CHAPTER CLXXV.

An Act to provide for the resurvey and Location of a State Road from St. Paul to Elliota.

SECTION 1. Commissioners named to lay out road.
2. Duties of Commissioners.
3. Per diem of Commissioners.
4. Act takes effect on passage.

Be it exacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That Isaac Decow, William H. Strong, and H. Coleburn, be and are hereby appointed Commissioners to Boundaries view, survey and re-locate that portion of a State Road from St. Paul to Elliota, as lays between Fillmore and Big Springs, in Fillmore County.
