An Act to establish the County of Wadena.

SECTION 1. Boundaries and name of the County.
2. Commissioners to be appointed by Governor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That so much territory as is embraced in the Boundaries and following described limits, be, and the same is hereby crename of coun- ated into the county of "Wadena," commencing at the southwest corner of township number one hundred and thirtyfour, range thirty-five west; thence north on said range line, to the north-west corner of township number one hundred and thirty-eight; thence east on said township line, between township lines number one hundred and thirty-eight and one hundred and thirty-nine to range line, between ranges thirtythree and thirty-two; thence south on said range line to the south-east corner of township number one hundred and thirtyfour, range thirty-three; thence west on township line, between townships number one hundred and thirty-three and one hundred and thirty-four to place of beginning. The county seat of said county of Wadena is hereby temporarily located at Wadena.

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SEC. 2. The Governor of the State shall appoint three Commissioners suitable persons a Board of County Commissioners for the to be appoint county named in this Act, who shall hold their respective offices until the next general election, and until their successors shall be duly elected and qualified; and the Commissioners to be appointed as aforesaid, shall have power to appoint all other county officers for their respective counties. who shall have full power and authority to do and perform

all acts which the Commissioners of other organized counties can do and perform.
