Sec. 2. That said Register of Deeds of the county of Freeborn, shall receive such compensation for copying said records, ^{Expenses how paid} and recording them in the county of Freeborn, as the Board of Supervisors of said county may contract for, which compensation shall be paid out of the treasurers office of the county of Freeborn, the said Board of Supervisors first auditing and approving said account.

Sec. 3. This Act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CLXXXVII.

An Act to amend An Act to lay out and establish a State Road from a point opposite Shakopee to Dayton in Hennepin County.

- SECTION 1. Amendment to Sec. 2, Chap. 19, [see page 125] relating to the commencement of the duties of the Commissioners.
2. Per diem of Commissioners.
 3. Chapter 19 declared of full force, except as repealed by this Act.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION. 1. That Section 2, of the Act entitled "An Act to

to read as follows :

SEC. 2. The said Commissioners or a majority of them,
shall meet at the office of Franklin Cook, in Hennepin county,
on the second Monday in July next, or as soon thereafter as
practicable, and proceed to survey and establish said road,
according to the provisions of Sec. 1, of this Act.

Per diem of **SEC. 2.** That the Commissioners appointed in said Act to
commissioners lay out said road, shall receive the sum of three dollars a
day for their services in laying out the same, and they are
hereby empowered to hire one surveyor, two chain-men, and
one axe-man.

Chap 19 in full **SEC. 3.** The said Act of which this is an amendment, is

SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect and be in force from

CHAPTER CLXXXVIII.

*An Act to authorize the County of Saint Louis to borrow
money to make Certain Improvements.*

- SECTION 1.** County Supervisors authorized to borrow money for erection
of County buildings.
2. Bonds to be paid in six years, and limit to rate of interest.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:
