Amendment to lay out and establish a State Road from a point opposite sec 2 chap 19 Shakopee, to Dayton in Hennepin county," be amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 2. The said Commissioners or a majority of them, shall meet at the office of Franklin Cook, in Hennepin county, on the second Monday in July next, or as soon thereafter as practicable, and proceed to survey and establish said road, according to the provisions of Sec. 1, of this Act.

Sec. 2. That the Commissioners appointed in said Act to Per diem of lay out said road, shall receive the sum of three dollars a day for their services in laying out the same, and they are hereby empowered to hire one surveyor, two chain-men, and one axe-man.

Chap 19 in full Sec. 3. The said Act of which this is an amendment, is force—exceptered and declared to be of full force and effect, except so much thereof as is hereby altered or amended.

CHAPTER CLXXXVIII.

An Act to authorize the County of Saint Louis to borrow money to make Certain Improvements.

Section 1. County Supervisors anthorized to borrow money for erection of County buildings.

2. Bonds to be paid in six years, and limit to rate of interest.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The Board of County Supervisors for the county Authorized to of Saint Louis, are hereby authorized to issue the bonds of borrow money the county for the sum of ten thousand dollars, for the purpose of erecting county buildings at Portland, in said county,

and for building bridges, and opening and improving roads

within the limits of said county.

Sec. 2. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate not exceeding twelve per cent. per annum, payable annually, and Bonds issued the terms of the bonds shall require the principal to be paid rate of interest within six years from the date of their issuing.

Sec. 3. This Act shall take effect from and after its pas-

sage.
