CHAPTER XIX.

An Act to lay out and establish a State Road from a point opposite Shakopee, to Dayton in Hennepin County.

- SECTION 1. Board of Commissioners—duties.
2. Meeting of Commissioners.
3. Deposit map of said road.
4. Power to appoint substitute.
5. Expense to be paid by the several counties.
6. Take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That James Sharver, Jr. Franklin Cook and Sterritt Anderson be and are hereby appointed commission-Commissioners
ers to lay out, make and establish a State road,—commencing
at a point oppsite the present city of Shakopee: running
thence to the Narrows of Minnetonka, at or near the resi-
dence of James Sharver, Jr: thence, on the most feasible route,
to Dayton in Hennepin County.

SEC. 2. The said commissioners or a majority of them
shall meet at the office of Franklin Cook, in Hennepin County, Meeting
on the first Monday in April next, and proceed to survey and
establish said road according to the provisions of section
first of this act.

SEC. 3. It is hereby made the duty of the above-named
commissioners to deposit a copy of the map of said road with Deposit map
the Register of Deeds of Hennepin County.

SEC. 4. If either of the above-named commissioners shall
be unable to perform the duties assigned to him, it shall be the Substitute
duty of the other commissioners to appoint substitutes in
their stead.

Expenses **SEC. 5.** The expenses incurred in the survey of said road shall be paid by the respective counties through which the road passes, in proportion to the distance within the respective counties.

Take effect **SEC. 6.** This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XX.

An Act for locating a State Road from Taylor's Falls in Chisago County to Hanover in Mille Lac County.

- SECTION 1.** Board of Commissioners.
 2. Meeting—Location to be made within six months.
 3. Report location—Deposit copy of survey.
 4. Power to appoint substitute.
 5. Expenses how paid.
 6. Take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That Levi W. Folsom and Patrick W. Davis, of **Commissioners** Chisago County, George F. Staples of Kanabec County, and Wm. Stevens of Mille Lac County, be and the same are hereby appointed commissioners to locate and mark a State road commencing at the north terminus of Medary-street in the town of Taylor's Falls, running from thence, on the most feasible and direct route, by Sunrise City, Cedar Lake and Bush Lake, to Brunswick in Kanabec County: from thence to Hanover in Mille Lac County.
