Be it cancted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Section 1. That Henry T. Fox, Richard Farral and James Appointment Stoward, be, and are hereby appointed Commissioners to lay of commission out, mark and establish a State Road commencing at the era town of La Crescent, running thence up the Valley of Pine Creek, and to intersect the territorial road at some point near Centerville.

SEC. 2. The said Commissioners, or a majority of them, First meeting shall meet at the office of H. T. Fox, in the town of La Cresent, County of Houston, on the third Monday of July next, and proceed to survey and establish said road according to the provisions of Section first in this Act.

Sec. 3. The expense of laying out and surveying said Expenses how road shall be paid by the counties through which said road may pass.

The Commissioners shall decide the proportion SEC. 4. Exponess by and amount of said expense to be paid by said counties whom paid through which said road may pass, and notify the Board of

Supervisors of each of said counties of the same.

Sec. 5. The above named Commissioners shall cause to by deposited in the offices of the Registers of Deeds of the Plat to be recounties through which said road may pass, a copy of the corded survey of the same,

SEC. 6. In the event either of the said Commissioners Power to ap-point substishall be unable to perform the duties assigned him in this Act, he shall have power to appoint a substitute, and it shall be his duty to notify the other Commissioners of such substitution.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That so much land as is contained in the town Roundaries of of Belmont, according to the survey and plat of said town, the town as made by C. C. Mead, for the proprietors of Belmont, and situated in the county of Jackson, and State of Minnesota, shall be a town corporate by the name of Belmont.

That for the good order and improvement of said First town et town, Josuah Dyen, is hereby appointed President, S. B. West-cers cott, D. P. Cornell, George A. Bardwell, and Frederic Noble, be and are hereby appointed Trustees, Charles G. Berry, Secretary, E. W. Northup, Attorney, and S. A. Farrington. Treasurer, and Geo. E. Leary, Marshal. The President, Trustees and Secretary shall constitute the Council of said town.

The male inhabitants of said town, being qualified Annual elecvoters, may at any election for State and county officers, and ties. once a year thereafter, elect successors to the aforesaid offices, who shall enter upon the duties of their offices on the first Wednesday in January, and shall before entering on
