

## CHAPTER OXOVIII.

*An Act to Incorporate the Town of Mansfield.*

- SECTION 1.<sup>o</sup> Boundaries of the town.  
 2. Corporate authorities of the town—how chosen.  
 3. Town site to be entered at Land Office.  
 4. Deeds of lots to persons entitled to be given by Common Council.  
 5. Record of survey to be filed with Register of Deeds.  
 6. First President of the Town—his duties.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That so much land as is contained in the town site of Mansfield, as surveyed by — Hopkins, be, and the same is hereby created a town corporate by the name of Mansfield, with all the powers, privileges and responsibilities usually enjoyed by municipal corporations. Boundaries of the town

SEC. 2. That the corporate authorities of said town shall be a President and Common Council, which shall be known as the President and Common Council of Mansfield; that for the good order and government of said town, it shall be lawful for the President thereof, on or before the first day of June, A. D. eighteen hundred and fifty-nine, to appoint not less than three discreet persons as the "Common Council," who shall serve until their successors be chosen and qualified, and who, with the consent of the President, shall have full power and authority to make and establish all needful rules and regulations for the government of said town corporate. Corporate authorities—how chosen

SEC. 3. It shall be the duty of the President, with the consent of the Council of said town corporate, to enter so much land within the corporate limits of said town as can be entered under the provisions of the Act of Congress, entitled "An Act for the relief of citizens of towns upon lands of the United States under certain circumstances," approved May twenty-three, eighteen hundred and forty-four. Town site to be entered

SEC. 4. It shall be the duty of the Common Council [of said town,] as soon as the title to said lands shall be obtained, pursuant to the third Section of this Act, to ascertain the number of persons entitled legally or equitably to lots or squares within the said town, and to deed under the hand of the President, and seal of the corporation, to every such person entitled as aforesaid, the lots or squares of land to which every such person may be entitled as aforesaid; *Provided*, That any person or persons to whom lots or squares shall be so deeded, shall previously have paid the sum of one dollar for each deed and acknowledgement, so required to be made. Deeds of lots to be given

Record of survey filed

SEC. 5. It shall be the duty of the President and Common Council to cause a plat of the survey of said town, to be recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of the county wherein said town is located, in conformity with the provisions of the statutes authorizing the record of town plats in this State.

First President of said town

to corporate

SEC. 6. That David H. Smith shall be the first President of said town corporate, and shall serve from and after the date of this Act, until his successor shall be chosen and qualified, under such rules and regulations as the Common Council, with the consent of the President, shall establish; and in the event of any vacancy, if of the President, the Common Council may fill the same; and if the Common Council, the same shall be filled by the President of the said town corporate.

SEC. 7. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

*An Act to authorize the City Council of the City of Stillwater to issue its Bonds, to build out, and construct a Levee in front of blocks Nos. 18, 27 and 28 in said city, and to erect and construct a City Hall.*
