Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That Levi W. Folsom and Patrick W. Davis, of Commissioners Chisago County, George F. Stayles of Kanabec County, and Wm. Stevens of Mille Lac County, be and the same are hereby appointed commissioners to locate and mark a State road commencing at the north terminus of Medary-street in the town of Taylor's Falls, running from thence, on the most feasible and direct route, by Sunrise City, Cedar Lake and Bush Lake, to Brunswick in Kanabec County: from thence to Hanover in Mille Lac County.

SEC. 2. That said commissioners or any two of them shall meet at such time and place to commence such location as they may deem most advisible: Provided, however, That said location must be made within six months from and after the passage of this act.
