## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That James Phillips, and Lewis Harrington, of McLeod county, and E. E. Payne, of Stearns county, be, Commissioners and are hereby appointed Commissioners to lay out and esappointed tablish a State Road from Glencoe, by way of Paynesville, to Saint Cloud in Steams county.

SEC. 2. The above named Commissioners, or a majority of them, shall meet at the office of Wm, S. Chapman, in Glen-Meeting of som coe, on the first Monday in March, or as soon thereafter as missioners practicable, and proceed to lay out, survey and establish said road.

SEC. 8. It shall be the duty of the aforesaid Commission-Plat to be re-earded eral Registers of Deeds of the counties through which the road will pass.
