

Joseph in Stearns County, via Richmond to Long Prairie in Todd County.

Sec. 2. The Commissioners so appointed, shall meet at St. Joseph, on the second Monday of May, or at such other <sup>Meeting of com-  
missioners</sup> time as they may agree upon, and proceed to survey, locate and establish said road in accordance with Section first of this Act, and shall complete the same and file a plat of said road in the office of the Register of Deeds of each of the counties through which said road is located, within six months next after the date of the passage of this Act. The said <sup>Draft of road  
to be deposited</sup> Commissioners are hereby authorized and empowered to procure a competent surveyor at an expense of not more than three dollars per day; and one axo-man and two chain-men, at an expense of not more than one dollar and fifty cents per day each. The said plat, before being filed as aforesaid, shall be certified to by the surveyor and at least two of said Commissioners, which certificate shall be legal evidence of the location of said road.

Sec. 3. If either of the Commissioners shall, from any <sup>Power to ap-  
point substi-  
tutes</sup> cause be unable to perform the duties herein assigned him, it shall be the duty of the others to appoint a substitute.

Sec. 4. The expense incurred in the location and survey of said road shall be paid by the counties through which the <sup>Expenses how  
paid</sup> same may pass.

Sec. 5. This Act shall take effect from and after its pas-  
sage.

## CHAPTER CXX.

*An Act to amend an Act entitled An Act to Incorporate the Mississippi River Improvement and Manufacturing Company, approved March 4, 1857.*

SECTION 1. Time of commencement of work extended.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

## CHAPTER COXL.

*An Act to lay out and establish a State Road from Glencoe, in McLeod County, via Paynesville, in Stearns County, to St. Cloud.*

- SECTION 1.** Appointment of Commissioners to lay out Road.  
2. First meeting of Commissioners.  
3. Plat of Road to be recorded.  
4. Expenses to be paid by counties through which road passes.

*Be it enacted by the Legislators of the State of Minnesota :*

**SECTION 1.** That James Phillips, and Lewis Harrington, of McLeod county, and E. E. Payne, of Stearns county, be, **Commissioners appointed** and are hereby appointed Commissioners to lay out and establish a State Road from Glencoe, by way of Paynesville, to Saint Cloud in Stearns county.

**Sec. 2.** The above named Commissioners, or a majority of them, shall meet at the office of Wm. S. Chapman, in Glencoe, on the first Monday in March, or as soon thereafter as practicable, and proceed to lay out, survey and establish said road. **Meeting of commissioners**

**Sec. 3.** It shall be the duty of the aforesaid Commissioners to file a map of the survey of said road with the several Registers of Deeds of the counties through which the road will pass. **Plat to be recorded**
