CHAPTER COXL.

An Act to lay out and establish a State Road from Glencoe, in McLeod County, via Paynesville, in Stearns County, to St. Cloud.

- SECTION 1. Appointment of Commissioners to lay out Road.
2. First meeting of Commissioners.
3. Plat of Road to be recorded.
4. Expenses to be paid by counties through which road passes.

Be it enacted by the Legislators of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That James Phillips, and Lewis Harrington, of McLeod county, and E. E. Payne, of Stearns county, be, Commissioners appointed and are hereby appointed Commissioners to lay out and establish a State Road from Glencoe, by way of Paynesville, to Saint Cloud in Stearns county.

SECTION 2. The above named Commissioners, or a majority of them, shall meet at the office of Wm. S. Chapman, in Glencoe, on the first Monday in March, or as soon thereafter as practicable, and proceed to lay out, survey and establish said road.

SECTION 3. It shall be the duty of the aforesaid Commissioners to file a map of the survey of said road with the several Registers of Deeds of the counties through which the road will pass.

SEC. 4. The expenses incurred in the establishing of the road, shall be paid by the several counties through which the road may be located. ^{Expenses how paid}

SEC. 5. This Act shall be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXXII.

An Act to provide for the location of a State Road from Faribault to Mankato.

- SECTION 1. Appointment of Commissioners to lay out State Road.
2. Meeting of Commissioners, and power to appoint substitutes.
3. Expenses of location paid by the counties through which the Road passes.
4. Commissioners to decide upon proportion of expenses to be paid by each county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That N. S. Messick, David B. Parsons, and David Campbell, be and the same are hereby appointed Commissioners to locate and mark out a State Road commencing at Faribault, in the county of Rice, and from thence by way of Warsaw, Morristown, Waterville and Okamou, on the most practicable route to Mankato in Blue Earth county. ^{Commissioners appointed}

SEC. 2. That said Commissioners shall meet on the first Monday in May, A. D. 1858, or as soon thereafter as convenient at the Barron House in said town of Faribault, and at said meeting shall appoint the time when said road shall be commenced, and in case either of the Commissioners ap- ^{Meeting of com- missioners Power to ap- point sub- stitutes}
