Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota?

SECTION I. That N. S. Messick, David B. Parsons, and Commissioners David Campbell, be and the same are hereby appointed Com-appointed missioners to locate and mark out a State Road commencing at Faribault, in the county of Rice, and from thence by way of Warsaw, Morristown, Waterville and Okamon, on the most practicable route to Mankato in Blue Earth county.

SEC. 2. That said Commissioners shall meet on the first Monday in May, A D. 1858, or as soon thereafter as conve-Meeting of comnient at the Barron House in said town of Faribault, and at missioners said meeting shall appoint the time when said road shall be point substicommenced, and in case either of the Commissioners ap-intes
