An Act to amend Section Light of Chapter Forty-four of the Entra Session, Approved May 28, A. D. 1857.

Section 1. Individual liability of stockholders in the Town of Ottowa for debts of the company.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION I. Section Eight of Chapter Forty-four, of the Act to incorporate the town of Ottowa, and for other purpoble for deless ses, is amended so as to read as follows: Each of the stockholders of said company shall be personally liable for the debts of said company to an amount equal to the amount of capital stock held by said stockholder and no more; and the said company may, by a majority vote, voting by shares, as aforesaid, increase the capital stock at any annual or special meeting of said company, regularly called according to the by-laws of said company.

CHAPTER COXVL

An Act for the Relief of Mary Miller.

Enormy 1. The nuncupative will of Charles Miller legalized.

2. Possession of property to be given to legates on giving bends for payment of debts of estate.

Be it exacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the nuncupative will of Charles Miller, late of Houston County, deceased, giving to Mary Miller, of said

The will legal county, all his lands, credits and effects, is hereby legalized, and an attested copy of said will recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Houston county, shall be sufficient to vest in the said Mary Miller the title of all lands belonging to the said Charles Miller at the time of his decease, subject to

the debts of said Charles Miller, and the expenses of administration.

Possession of property given to legates

Sec. 2. If the said Mary Miller shall give bonds to the Judge of Probate of Houston County, in such sum and such sureties as he shall direct, and approve, with condition to pay all the debts and liabilities against said estate, and the expenses of administration, within such time as the Judge of Probate shall direct; and such Judge of Probate shall make a decree, giving to said Mary Miller the immediate possession and full control of the property, both real and personal, of the said deceased.

CHAPTER COXVII.

An Act to authorize the Board of Supervisors of Wright County to Borrow Money.

SECTION 1. Supervisors authorized to borrow money for erection of County buildings.

Faith of county to be pledged for payment of interest and principal.

3. Use of the money so borrowed.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the Board of Supervisors of Wright County borrow money be, and are hereby authorized, and empowered to borrow a sum of money not exceeding twelve thousand dollars, at a rate of interest not exceeding twelve per cent. per annum, and for a term not exceeding ten years.
