

The will legalized county, all his lands, credits and effects, is hereby legalized, and an attested copy of said will recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Houston county, shall be sufficient to vest in the said Mary Miller the title of all lands belonging to the said Charles Miller at the time of his decease, subject to the debts of said Charles Miller, and the expenses of administration.

Possession of property given to legatee SEC. 2. If the said Mary Miller shall give bonds to the Judge of Probate of Houston County, in such sum and such sureties as he shall direct, and approve, with condition to pay all the debts and liabilities against said estate, and the expenses of administration, within such time as the Judge of Probate shall direct; and such Judge of Probate shall make a decree, giving to said Mary Miller the immediate possession and full control of the property, both real and personal, of the said deceased.

CHAPTER COXVII.

An Act to authorize the Board of Supervisors of Wright County to Borrow Money.

- SECTION 1. Supervisors authorized to borrow money for erection of County buildings.
2. Faith of county to be pledged for payment of interest and principal.
 3. Use of the money so borrowed.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Supervisors to borrow money SECTION 1. That the Board of Supervisors of Wright County be, and are hereby authorized, and empowered to borrow a sum of money not exceeding twelve thousand dollars, at a rate of interest not exceeding twelve per cent. per annum, and for a term not exceeding ten years.

SEC. 2. The said Board of Supervisors are hereby author-

ized and empowered to pledge the faith of said county for the payment of said loan, by bonds duly executed by the said Board, under the seal of the sa'id county. Faith of county pledged for payment

SEC. 3. The said Board of Supervisors are hereby authorized and empowered to use the money so borrowed for the purchase or erection, and completion of county buildings. Use of money

SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXXVIII

An Act to amend an Act entitled An Act to amend Chapter 36 of the Revised Statutes, and passed March 1, 1856.

SECTION 1. Amendment to Chapter 1, of the Session Laws of 1856.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of the Act above recited, be, and the same is hereby amended by striking out in the clause enumerated therein, as Section 24 of Chapter 36, the word "twelve," between the word "last" and the word "months," and substituting therefor the word "three." Amendment to chapter one

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect from and after its passage.
