CHAPTER CCXXI.

An Act to amend an Act entitled An Act to amend An Act of the Incorporation of the Nininger, Saint Peter and Western Railroad, approved March 3d, 1858.

SECTION 1. Amendment to the Incorporation Act of Nininger Saint Peter and Western Railroad Company, concerning the laying of tracts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That all of Section 1 of the said Act, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows: The said corporation is hereby authorized and empowered to survey, locate, construct, complete, alter, maintain and operate as a railroad, with one or more tracks, or lines of rails, from a point on the Mississippi River, within the city of Nininger, to the city of Saint Peter, on the Minnesota River, by way of the town of Louisville, and Henderson, on the said Minnesota River, together with a branch road from the said town of Louisville, on the Minnesota River, with one or more tracks or lines of rails by way of Carver and Young America, in Carver county, to Glencoe, the county seat of

McLeod county, thence to Eagle City, in Sibley county, upon as direct a line between the points above mentioned as practicable, which shall be determined by the Board of Directors with reference to the best route therefor.

Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER COXXII.

SECTION 1. Amendment to City Charter, relating to duties of City Surveyor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That Chapter three of an Act to amend an Act to incorporate the City of Stillwater, approved March 1st, A. D. 1856, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 18. The City Surveyor shall cause to be established at some convenient point in a public street, an initial fixed point, from which the street surveys shall be conducted, and whenever the City Council shall establish the grade lines of any streets, alleys, levees or wharves, they shall cause a full record to be made of the elevations, and all other matters that they may deem necessary for a full understanding in regard to said grades, in a book to be kept for that purpose, by the City Surveyor, and whenever the grades of any
