## CHAPTER CXXXIX.

*An Act to amend an Act entitled An Act to provide for the laying out of certain State Roads in the State of Minnesota, and to amend an amendment to the same.*

- SECTION 1. Change in location of State Road from Quibay to Princeton.  
 2. Repeal of State Road from Township 22, Range 22, Ramsey County, to Williams' Ferry.  
 3. Change in location &c., from Henderson to Nobles' Wagon Road.  
 4. Change in location &c., from Mankato to Nobles' Wagon Road.  
 5. Relocation of road from Mankato to Brownsville.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That Section fifty-four of said Act is hereby amended so as to read via "Elk Lake" in lieu of "Hayden's Lake." Change in loc.  
tion of road

SEC. 2. That Section forty-nine of said Act is hereby repealed. Repealed

SEC. 3. That Section one of said Act is hereby amended by striking out the name of J. B. Calkins, and inserting the name of Fred. Rehfeld. And after the road leaves New Ulm, at or near the house of John Dans, and running to the middle line of section thirty-four (34), township one hundred and ten (110), range thirty-one, at a convenient point, thence west on said line as far as practicable. Change in loc.  
tion

SEC. 4. That Section seventy-three of said Act is hereby amended by striking out the name of J. B. Calkins, and inserting the name of Fred. Rehfeld. And after crossing the Big Cottonwood, to intersect the road from New Ulm to Nobles Wagon Road, at the middle line of Section thirty-four (34), township one hundred and ten (110), range thirty-one (31), at the same point that the road from New Ulm intersects said line.

SEC. 5. That Section thirty-two (32) of said Act is hereby amended as follows: Commencing at Crystal Lake City, Change in loc.

and running by the most feasible route, via Madelia, in Brown county, and Odessa, in Jackson county, to some point at or near the Falls of the Big Sioux River.

Sec. 6. That George Stamison, John Nelson, and Edmond Bell, are hereby appointed Commissioners to re-locate and establish such portion of the Territorial Road, from Brownsville to Mankato, as lays between Gilbert Anderson's, in township one hundred and one (101), range six (6), to section sixteen (16), in township one hundred and one (101), range seven (7), and from thence in a north westerly direction to a point of junction with the Territorial Road running from Brownsville to Mankato.
