## OHAPTER XXIV.

An Act to provide for location of a State Road fromBrownsville, in Houston County, to Shell Rock City, in Irreeborn County.

Beormon 1. Board of Commissioners-Daties.
2. Meeting of Comminasionera-appoint substitates.
3. Make draft of location of Rosd.
4. Expentes to be paid by the several countieb-per aiem of Commisaionera.
5. Take effeet.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:
Sec. 1. That Embrick Knudson, A. K. Bartlett and DaComminaloners vid Caswell, are hereby appointed Commissioners to locate and mark oat a State Road from Brownsville; in Houston county, State of Minnesota, by way of Caledonia, Spring Grove, Hmbrick Knudson's, Bellville, Elliota and LeRoy, thence across the Big Gedar River, on or near the line between sections twenty-one and twentyeight, Township one handred and one, range eighteen, to Shell Rock City, in Freeborn county.

Sec. 2. That gaid Commissioners shall meet at Browns-ville, on or before the first day of June, 1858, and proceed to discharge the duties imposed upon them by the provisions. of this act: Provided, however, That in the absence of any one of said Commissioners appointed by this act, the others may have power to supply said vacancy by appointing another Commissioner, or may, in case a majority of them meet, proceed in discharging their duties.

Ske. 8. Said Commissioners shall make out a fair and

Draft of road accarate draft of the location of said road, one copy whereof shall be deposited in the office of the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of the respective counties through which said road may pass.

Sic. 4. That the necessary expenses incurred for laying out said road shall be paid by the counties through which said road may pass. Each county tax for the same shall be set forth up on the certificate of said Commissioners, including the costs of survey : Procided, howecer, That said Commissioners shall be allowed the sum of three dollars per day, for every day necessarily employed in performing the duties assigned by this sct, and said Commissioners are hereby anthorized to emply one surveyor at three dollars per day, two chainmen, and onc axeman, at a sum not exceeding one dollar and fifty cents per day.

## OHAPTER XXV.

## An Act to lay out and mark a State Road from St. Part via Lake Como to Superior.

Secrios. 1. Board of Commiserioners, -
2. Location of Road. -
3. Meating of Board. Expenses how paid.
4. Fille plat of said Road with Registor of Deeds.
5. Powor to appoint sabatitntes.
6. Take efliet.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:
Sxc. 1. That George Scotten, John P. Owens and A. A. Comminetonerns Parker, be, and the same arc hereby appointed Commissioners, to locate a State Road from St. Yaul via Lake Como to Superior.

Sxc. 2. Said road shall commence at the north terminas of Wabashaw street in St. Paul; thence in the same direction of Wabashaw street, to the Point Douglas and Fort Ripley road; thence along said road to a point 750 feet east of of the centre ot section 36, town 29, north of range 23, west; and running thence in a north-west direction, to a point 33 feet east of the south-west corner of section 25, in said township and range aforesaid; thence north-westerly, running east of Lake Como, to a point 378 feet west of the 4 post on the north side of section 23 ; thence by the most feasible roate to intersect the St. Paul and Superior road at some point in or near section 17, in township 31, north of range 29, west of the fourth principal meredian.
