

CHAPTER XXIV.

An Act to provide for location of a State Road from Brownsville, in Houston County, to Shell Rock City, in Freeborn County.

- SECTION 1.** Board of Commissioners—Duties.
 2. Meeting of Commissioners—appoint substitutes.
 3. Make draft of location of Road.
 4. Expenses to be paid by the several counties—per diem of Commissioners.
 5. Take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Commissioners SEC. 1. That Embrick Knudson, A. K. Bartlett and David Caswell, are hereby appointed Commissioners to locate and mark out a State Road from Brownsville, in Houston county, State of Minnesota, by way of Caledonia, Spring Grove, Embrick Knudson's, Bellville, Elliota and LeRoy, thence across the Big Cedar River, on or near the line between sections twenty-one and twenty-eight, Township one hundred and one, range eighteen, to Shell Rock City, in Freeborn county.

Meeting—all vacancy SEC. 2. That said Commissioners shall meet at Brownsville, on or before the first day of June, 1858, and proceed to discharge the duties imposed upon them by the provisions of this act: *Provided, however,* That in the absence of any one of said Commissioners appointed by this act, the others may have power to supply said vacancy by appointing another Commissioner, or may, in case a majority of them meet, proceed in discharging their duties.

Draft of road SEC. 3. Said Commissioners shall make out a fair and accurate draft of the location of said road, one copy whereof shall be deposited in the office of the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of the respective counties through which said road may pass.

Expenses how paid—Per diem SEC. 4. That the necessary expenses incurred for laying out said road shall be paid by the counties through which said road may pass. Each county tax for the same shall be set forth up on the certificate of said Commissioners, including the costs of survey: *Provided, however,* That said Commissioners shall be allowed the sum of three dollars per day, for every day necessarily employed in performing the duties assigned by this act, and said Commissioners are hereby authorized to employ one surveyor at three dollars per day, two chainmen, and one axeman, at a sum not exceeding one dollar and fifty cents per day.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect from and after its passage. Take effect

CHAPTER XXV.

An Act to lay out and mark a State Road from St. Paul via Lake Como to Superior.

- SECTION. 1. Board of Commissioners. ~
2. Location of Road.
3. Meeting of Board. Expenses how paid.
4. File plat of said Road with Register of Deeds.
5. Power to appoint substitutes.
6. Take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SEC. 1. That George Scotten, John P. Owens and A. A. Commissioners Parker, be, and the same are hereby appointed Commissioners, to locate a State Road from St. Paul via Lake Como to Superior.

SEC. 2. Said road shall commence at the north terminus of Wabashaw street in St. Paul; thence in the same direction of Wabashaw street, to the Point Douglas and Fort Ripley road; thence along said road to a point 750 feet east of the centre of section 36, town 29, north of range 23, west; and running thence in a north-west direction, to a point 33 feet east of the south-west corner of section 25, in said township and range aforesaid; thence north-westerly, running east of Lake Como, to a point 378 feet west of the $\frac{1}{4}$ post on the north side of section 23; thence by the most feasible route to intersect the St. Paul and Superior road at some point in or near section 17, in township 31, north of range 22, west of the fourth principal meridian.
