CHAPTER XXVII.

An Act to lay out and establish a State Road from Shakopee in Scott County to Kasota in Le Sueur County.

- SECTION 1.** Board of Commissioners---duties.
 .2. Meeting of Board.
 3. Duty of Surveyor to deposit copy of map.
 4. Expenses to be paid by the several counties.
 5. Surveyor's per diem.
 6. Take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Commissioners **SECTION 1.** That Henry Dewitt, Zenas Wise and J. London-burger are hereby appointed Commissioners to lay out and establish a State Road,—commencing at Shakopee: running thence to Holena: thence, by the most feasible route, by the way of Lexington, to Kasota.

Meeting **SEC. 2.** The said Commissioners, or a majority of them, shall meet at Kasota, on the first Tuesday in April next, and proceed to survey and establish said road according to the provisions of the first section of this act.

Filing maps
&c **SEC. 3.** It is hereby made the duty of the Surveyor to deposit a copy of the map of the survey of said road with the Register of Deeds in Le Sueur and Scott Counties.

SEC. 4. The expense incurred by the survey and establishing said road shall be paid by the said Counties of Scott and Le Sueur. Expenses

SEC. 5. The Surveyor shall receive for each day's service in surveying said road four dollars: each chainman and axeman two dollars. Per diem

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect from and after its passage. Take effect

An Act to Provide for the Construction of a State Road from Blue Earth City to Shell Rock City.

- SECTION 1. Board of Commissioners.
 2. Meeting of Board.
 3. Power to employ Surveyor. Per diem.
 4. Expenses to be paid by the several counties.
 5. Power to appoint substitute.
 6. Per diem.
 7. Take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That William W. Knapp, Theophilus Brown, and A. M. Burnham, be and are hereby appointed Commissioners to survey and locate a State Road from Blue Earth City, in Faribault county, via Walnut Lake, (so called,) Albert Lea, to Shell Rock City, in Freeborn county. Commissioners

SEC. 2 Said Commissioners shall meet at the office of J. A. Keister, Esq., in Blue Earth City, on the first Monday of May, A. D. 1858, or as soon thereafter as is practicable, and proceed to lay out and mark said Road by the most feasible route. Meeting
