

CHAPTER XXXVIII.

An Act to amend Act entitled an Act to Incorporate the Town of La Crescent. Approved January 27, 1857.

- SECTION 1. Amendment to Charter, concerning votes for specific improvements.
 2. Assessors to be appointed by Council.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That Section thirteen (13) be amended by the following addition : " And after a vote to levy an additional tax for a specific improvement in said town has been taken, and ascertained to be in favor of such additional tax, no additional vote shall be necessary. The said Council is then authorized and required to levy an annual tax sufficient to pay the annual payments of any money borrowed by said Council to make or complete such specific improvements.

Amendment to section 13 of charter

SEC. 2. Hereafter the Town Council shall appoint the Assessor or Assessors of the taxable property for town purposes, within said corporation, and all that may hereafter be added ; and after the assessment is made, and returned to the Recorder or President of said Council, the Town Council, in levying a tax, shall base the same on such assessment, subject to such corrections as is provided for in the corrections of county assessments, hereby contravening the provisions of Sections 13 and 14 inconsistent with the above.
