Beginning at the north-east corner of Township one hundred and twenty-two (122) Range twenty-nine (29) west; thence due west on the township line between Boundary one hundred and twenty-two and three (122 and 123) to the north-west corner of Township one hundred and twenty-two (122), Range thirty-three (33) west of the fifth principal meridian.

SEC. 2. At the next general election the electors of the Counties of Meeker and Steams, shall vote for or against the Vote on its adoption of said line.

Sec. 3. This Act to take effect from and after its adoption.
