

CHAPTER LXIV.

An Act to establish the County of Toombs.

- SECTION 1. Boundaries of the proposed county—location of county-seat.
 2. Appointment of County Commissioners and other county officers..
 3. Attached to Fourth Judicial District.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Boundaries of
the county

SECTION 1. That so much territory as is embodied in the following limits be, and the same is hereby established as the County of Toombs: Beginning at the junction of the Bois des Sioux River with the Red River of the North; thence down the main channel of said river on the boundary line of this State, fifteen miles; thence in a line due east to the Pelican River; thence down the said river to its intersection with the Otter-Tail River or Red River of the North; thence in a line due south to the Chippewa River; thence in a direct line to the mouth of Lake Travers; thence down the main channel of the Bois des Sioux River, on the boundary line of this State, to the place of beginning. The county-seat of said county is hereby located at Breckenridge.

SEC. 2. The Governor shall appoint three suitable persons who shall constitute a Board of County Commissioners for said county, who shall hold their offices until the next general election or until their successors are duly elected and qualified; and the said Board of Commissioners shall have power to appoint all other county officers in and for said county; and said Commissioners shall have full power and authority to do and perform all acts and duties devolving upon the Board of County Commissioners of any other county in this State.
