Be it enacted by the Lezislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That so much of the State of Minnesota as lies within the following boundaries, be, and the same is Boundaries of hereby established as the County of Douglas. Beginning at the county the north-east corner of township one hundred and thirty (130), north of range thirty-six (36), west of the fifth principal meridian, thence west to the north-west corner of township one hundred and thirty (130), north of range forty (40), west, thence south between ranges forty (40), and forty-one (41), to the south-west corner of township one hundred and twenty-seven (127), north of range forty (40), west, thence east to the south-east corner of township one hundred and twenty-seven (127), north of range thirty-six (36), west, thence north between ranges thirty-five (35), and thirty-six (36), west, to the place of beginning.

The Governor shall appoint three suitable persons County comwho shall act as the Board of County Commissioners for said missioners. county, who shall hold their office until the next general term of officers election, or until their successors shall be elected and qualified: and the said Board of Commissioners shall have power to appoint all other county officers, and said Commissioners shall have full power and authority to do and perform all

missioners of any organized county in this State.
